

## NFCC BIKINI RACE

Date: Sunday, September 13, 1981      Registration: 900 - 1030  
Place: Navy Jax Yacht Club      Skipper's Meeting: 1100  
Start: 1200

ENTRIES: \$7.50 during registration at Navy Jax Yacht Club.

ELIGIBILITY: Valid PHRF rating certificate. Must be presented at registration.

MANAGEMENT: The race will be under the management of the North Florida Cruising Club which shall have full power to interpret these conditions. It is the responsibility of the owner and the master of each yacht to see that his vessel is seaworthy in hull, rig and gear.

RACING RULES: The current Racing Rules of the International Yacht Racing Union as adopted by the U.S. Yacht Racing Union shall govern except as modified by these instructions.

IDENTIFICATION: All vessels are required to have unique markings on the mainsail, as stated under "sail #" on the entry form. Boats of the same make must be distinguishable by the race committee.

DIVISIONS: Spinnaker  
Non-Spinnaker

INFRACTION OF RULES: Graduated penalties as provided in Appendix 3 of the 1981 Racing Rules will apply. The committee may also impose penalties for infringement of these sailing instructions. The 720° rule will not be in effect.

CREW: The minimum crew shall be two persons. Any change in the crew listed on the entry form must be reported to the Race Committee prior to the start of the race. Minimum - 50% female. Female at the helm at all times.

### NORMAL COURSE:

1. Start between the committee boat and starting marker located east of Navy Jax Yacht Club.
2. Proceed north, rounding marker "5" to port.
3. Proceed west, rounding FYC marker "A" to starboard.
4. Proceed NNE, rounding marker "3" to starboard.
5. Proceed south and finish between committee boat and starting mark in opposite direction of start.

SHORTENED COURSE: If the first boat has not rounded marker "A" on the above course, within 2 hours of the start of the race, she shall sail the shortened course as follows:

1. Round marker "5" and marker "A" as stated in normal course paragraph 2 and 3 above.
2. Proceed to finish between committee boat and mark in opposite direction of start.

PROTESTS: Protests must be presented to Race Committee within one hour after finishing.
