DEAR SKIPPER:

You are cordially invited to participate in the St. Augustine Yacht Club's FOURTH ANNUAL RACE OF THE CENTURY which will be sailed on May 30, 1982, following the North Florida Cruising Club's Mayport to St. Augustine Race (Saturday May 29th) and on Monday, May 31, (Memorial Day), our Bikini Cup for the ladies. In the past, these races have attracted some very good competition and this year should be even better. To enter the RACE OF THE CENTURY, please read the instructions below, complete the attached entry form, and return the completed form to the St. Augustine Yacht Club no later than WEDNESDAY, MAY 26, 1982 with your \$10.00 entry fee.

RATINGS:

The races will be sailed using the PHRF rating system and every boat will be required to have a valid certificate from PHRF of North Florida.

The fleet will be divided into three or more PHRF classes based on ratings, with trophies awarded for each class. In addition, provided at least five non-spinnaker boats enter, trophies will be awarded for a non-spinnaker Cruiser Class. Please indicate your rating, or "applied for," on the entry form and indicate whether the boat has a spinnaker.

DOCKAGE: Dockage will be available at the Comachee Cove Yacht Harbor (just North of Vilano Bridge). The rate is \$7.00 per night for any boat, side tie or raft (\$35.00 weekly). Electric. if available, is \$2.50 extra per night. Side tie slips will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis so early reservations are encouraged. Reservations must be made with Comachee Cove Yacht Harbor (Jax) 358-7082, or (St. Aug.) 829-5676. Submission of an entry form does not constitute a reservation for dockage.

REGISTRATION: Upon arrival Saturday evening at the SAYC, each captain should register his boat on the lower level of the club and pick up his/her registration package. This package will include the following:

- (1) Written race instructions
- (2) Class Identification Ribbon
- (3) Dinner tickets (if paid for in advance)
- (4) One Race of the Century T-shirt

The above, except for dinner tickets, are included in the \$10.00 registration fee. Additional t-shirts and patches may be purchased if desired at the club.

DINNER SATURDAY EVENING: On Saturday evening, May 29th, the SAYC will host a barbeque dinner for all captains and crews of boats participating in the Mayport to St. Augustine Race. The dinner price is \$6.00. Serving will begin at approximately 1830 hours. Since a limited number of dinners will be

available, dinner reservations must be made on your entry form and the appropriate fee included with your registration fee. Winners of the Mayport-St. Augustine Race will be announced Saturday evening at the barbeque dinner.

SKIPPERS MEETING: On Sunday morning at 0800 hours coffee and donuts will be served at the The Skippers Meeting will begin promptly at 0900 hours. Please note that ATTENDANCE AT THE SKIPPERS MEETING IS MANDATORY.

If at all possible, trophies will be presented Sunday afternoon after the race.
