at the Rudder Club on Friday evening, November 18.


..Enjoy the dinner dance at the Dolphin Room,

## RULES

The race will be governed by the International Yacht Racing Rules, the prescriptions of the USYRU, and by the sailing instructions.

## ELIGIBILITY

- Single hull, enclosed cabin.
- Yachts must have a valid rating certificate from PHRF of NE FLA.
- Sail numbers on mainsails, spinnakers and headsails having a LP exceeding 130% of base of the foretriangle.
- Completing registration with SJRSA.
- Limit 125 yachts.
- Rating can be obtained at the Friday night registration party at the Rudder Club.

## CLASSES

The fleet will be divided into:  
Division I (spinnakers) and  
Division II (non-spinnakers).  
Flashers will sail in Division I. The divisions will be divided into classes according to PHRF ratings.
