

NFCC St. Augustine Race - Sailing Instructions

DATE: May 26, 1984 Saturday

ENTRIES and REGISTRATION: The standard Race Entry form must be postmarked no later than May 19, Saturday. No entries, either by mail or hand delivery will be accepted after 1600 hours May 24, 1984. Send entry to: George Marsch, 3863 San Bernado Dr., Jacksonville, FL 32217. Entry can also be turned in at the May 17 meeting of NFCC. Each entry must be accompanied by \$7.50 fee.

ELIGIBILITY: All entrants must have a 1984 PHRF of NE Florida Certificate for rating. Minimum size for entry is 20 feet length overall. This is a category 4 race as regards to minimum equipment and accomodations.

MANAGEMENT: By the North Florida Cruising Club. It is the responsibility of each skipper to insure that his yacht is seaworthy in hull, equipment, and rig. The decision to participate, start, and continue in this race rests solely with each yacht's master.

SKIPPER MEETING: These instructions will act in lieu of a skipper's meeting.

SAFETY: All entrants shall check in with the race committee start boat at least fifteen minutes prior to the warning signal of the first classes start. Any yacht which retires from the race shall notify the race committee immediately so all starters can be accounted for.

CLASSES: The fleet will be broken into spinnaker and non-spinnaker classes. Classes within these divisions will also be made according to number of entrants.

Scratch sheets will be available from the race committee the morning of the race. If you desire a scratch sheet, notify the R.C. boat when you check in and they will pass you one.

START: All classes will receive their warning signal at 0850 EDST and start at 0900. NOTE: The starting line will be between the race committee boat and a special starting mark. The starting mark will be located 300 meters north of St. John's channel buoy R"4". The R.C. boat will be located north of the starting buoy.

COURSE: Proceed in an easterly direction from the starting line to St. John's channel buoy R"2StJ" leaving it to starboard, thence to special buoy W Or"A" (145-3.4 NM) leaving it to starboard and then to the finish line.

FINISH: Finish in a southerly direction between a race committee boat and St. Augustine buoy "StA" leaving the buoy to starboard. Should the R.C. boat not be on station, each yacht shall record their time when "StA" bears 270 degrees and is within 100 meters.

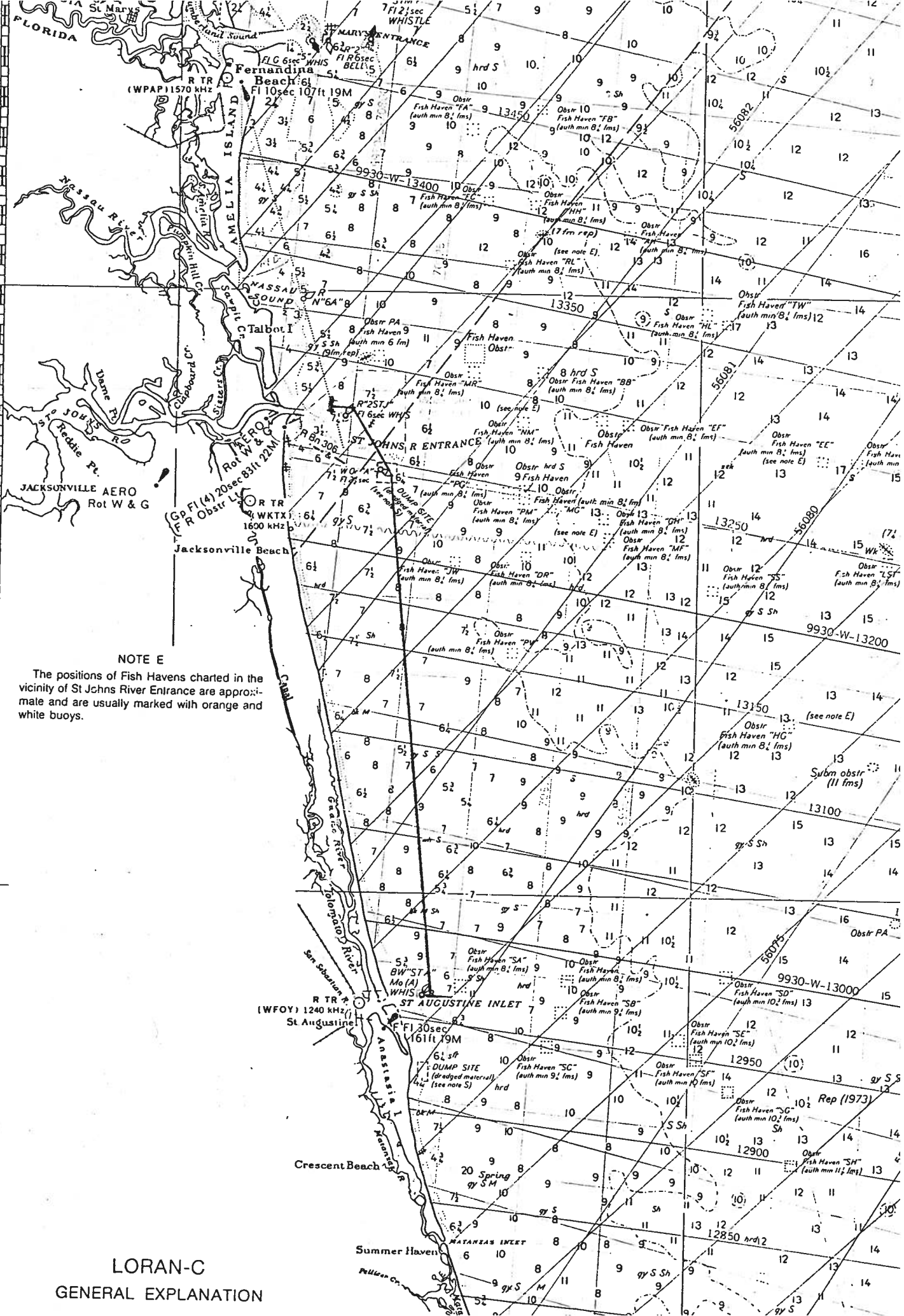
INDIVIDUAL and GENERAL RECALL: As prescribed in the 1981-1984 IYRU-USYRU Rule book.

SHORTENED COURSE: None.

TIME LIMIT: None.

PENALTIES: The 720 degree turns penalty as provided in rule 74.5 and the alternative penalties of Appendix 2 of the IYRU Rules will be in effect.

PROTESTS: Must be presented in writing to the race committee within three hours of finishing.
