NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. (RRS) 2009-2012, The Prescriptions of US SAILING and by the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Spinnaker and non-spinnaker classes will be all female crew. Cruiser class: up to 50% of crew can be male. The boat must be helmed by a female from the preparatory signal of her class until finished. No male shall touch the helm while racing.
- 2.2 All boats are encouraged to have a valid PHRF rating, but may obtain an uncontestable temporary WSS rating for the Women's Sailing Series.
- 2.3 All boats shall have their sail numbers on the mainsail, spinnakers, and each headsail having a LP measurement exceeding 130% of the base of the fore triangle.
- **2.4** Eligible boats may enter by completing the FCSA Standard Entry Form found at www.sailjax.com and sending it together with \$30 fee in advance, or on race day during registration. Make checks payable to Navy Jacksonville Yacht Club. Advance registration forms can be mailed with entry fee to:

4. FEES

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 The sailing instructions will be available at 0930 hrs on race day. Changes to this notice or the Sailing Instructions will be posted on the exterior bulletin board by 1000 hrs on race day. Sailing instructions will also be available on the water from the Race Committee prior to the start. The Committee Boat will monitor channel 68.

6. VENUE

6.1 The racing area will be in the St. Johns River as depicted on NOAA Chart 11492 between the Buckman Bridge to the south and the Fuller Warren Bridge to the north.

7. THE COURSE

7.1 The course to be sailed will be as shown at the Sailors Meeting and displayed on the committee boat.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

8.1 Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in rule 70.4.

9. SCORING

- **9.1** The Low-point Scoring System, Appendix A, Rule A4.1 of the racing rules, will apply for this regatta.

10. PRIZES

10.1 All participants and their guest are invited to the social and awards presentation at the NJYC club house after the race. Mothers will be honored!

11. BASE PASSES

11.1 A representative from NJYC will be at the main gate 9:30 to 10:30 am on the day of the race to help with base entrance. All persons entering the base must have a picture ID. All vehicles must have and provide proof of current registration and insurance.
