NOTICE OF RACE

RULES

The Regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RSS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, the rules of PHRF and this NOR. These may be altered by the Sailing Instructions.

ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 All female crews are encouraged to register. Competitor's requirements for mixed crew eligibility sailings are: at least 50% of those aboard shall be female and the boat must be helmed by a female from the preparatory signal until that boat finishes.
- 2.2 All boats must have a valid PHRF rating from First Coast Sailing Association.
 - Boats not having a valid rating may obtain an uncontestable temporary WSS rating.
- 2.3 Participating boats shall have their sail number on the mainsail, spinnakers and headsails with an LP exceeding 130%.
- 2.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing registration with the Rudder Club, which is the organizing authority.

CLASSES

- 3.1 PHRF Spinnaker (All Female), PHRF Non-Spinnaker (All Female), and Cruiser-Mixed Crew.
- 3.2 Boats sailing with a mixed crew (50/50) will sail in the Cruiser-Mixed Crew class.
- 3.3 Spinnakers are allowed in the PHRF Spinnaker All Female Class only.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 4.1 Friday, November 5: Complimentary docking at Rudder Club the night prior to the race.
- 4.2 Saturday, November 6: 10:00-11:00 a.m. Registration; 12:00 Competitors Meeting; 1:00 p.m. Start

ENTRY FEE/REGISTRATION

Entry fee is \$25. Mail check payable to The Rudder Club and accompanied by an entry form (from The Rudder Club's website http://www.rudderclub.com or the form at http://www.sailjax.com.) Boats may also register between the hours of 10:00 thru 11:00 a.m. on the day of the race.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6 Sailing Instructions will be available before the Competitors Meeting on the day of the race.

COURSES

7 Courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

SCORING THE RACE

- 8.1 Each boat starting and finishing the race, and not thereafter retiring or being disqualified, will be scored points equal to her finishing place in class.
- 8.2 Boats not so scored shall be scored according to the Racing Rules of Sailing Appendix A.
- 8.3 The lowest score wins.
- 8.4 Results of this race will be forwarded to the Northeast Florida Women's Sailing Network for inclusion in the computation for Series scoring.

RACE PRIZES

First, second and third place prizes will be awarded in classes with five or more boats. Fewer prizes may be awarded in classes with fewer than five boats.
