# NOTICE OF RACE AND SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

# **Bi-Annual St. Augustine Race**

# SATURDAY, MAY 23, 2015

### Atlantic Ocean, from St. Johns River Inlet to St. Augustine Inlet

### 1.0 RULES

The race will be governed in order of precedence by (1) this Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions; (2) the rules of the First Coast Sailing Association; and (3) The Racing Rules of Sailing, 2013-2016 (RRS).

# 2.0 MANAGEMENT

The race will be managed by the North Florida Cruising Club, which is also the organizing authority.

# 3.0 ELIGIBILITY

- **3.1** The race is open to all yachts with a current PHRF certificate from the First Coast Sailing Association (FCSA <u>www.sailjax.com</u> )
- **3.2** Yachts that do not have a current PHRF rating assigned by the FCSA may obtain a provisional new rating (\$35.00 first-time annual fee) that will be submitted to FCSA for formal review. The NFCC Club Handicapper is Bill Weinbecker (<u>william.weinbecker@gmail.com</u>)
- **3.3** A yacht participating in the Spinnaker or Non-Spinnaker Class shall have sail numbers on the mainsails, spinnakers, and all headsails with an LP exceeding 130% of J. A yacht sailing in the Cruiser Class shall have an identifying sail number on her mainsail.

# 4.0 REGISTRATION and ENTRY FEE

- **4.1** The standard FCSA race entry form (<u>www.sailjax.com/Standard-Race-Entry-Form.pdf</u>) must be completed in full, and along with the appropriate fee shall be filed with the Race Committee before 20:00 hrs Friday, May 22.
- **4.2** Participants are encouraged to register in advance by sending the completed form with the appropriate fee to: Barbara Sperbeck, NFCC Race Committee, PO Box 24268, Jacksonville, FL 32260. Registration documents may also be submitted at the Sisters Creek docks on Friday evening, *but please don't wait until then*.
- **4.3** The entry fee is \$25.00 for NFCC Members, and \$30.00 for non-members (\$25.00 if US Sailing Member). Make checks payable to: North Florida Cruising Club.

# 5.0 CLASSES

The fleet will be divided into three classes: Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker, and Cruiser. Classes may be further divided into Divisions if the number of entries permit.

# 7.0 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

There will be no Notices to Competitors other than this document.

#### 8.0 **TIME**

All published times used in association with the race will be Eastern Daylight Saving Time (UTC 2015-NoR,05-23,NFCC,St-Augustine-Race.docx April 22, 2015



minus 4 hours in 24 hour format). Race Committee time will be synchronized with the US Naval Observatory Master Clock telephone voice announcer: 202-762-1401 or 202-762-1069. Each yacht's timekeeper shall synchronize their timepiece to this standard.

#### 9.0 THE START

#### 9.1 There will be no RC boat at the start line:

Yachts shall start at or after 09:30:00 as synchronized with USNO time (refer to 8.0). A yacht shall have started when, while proceeding easterly, it crosses an imaginary line connecting St. Johns entrance buoys G-3 (30:23.754 N; 81:21.638 W) and R-4 (30:23.894 N; 81:21.605 W).

- 9.2 After starting, Cruiser class yachts shall proceed directly to the finish.
- **9.3** After starting, Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker class yachts shall proceed to the St. Johns River Entrance buoy 'STJ' (30:23.589 N; 81:19.140 W) leaving it to starboard, then proceed to the finish.
- **9.4** Each yacht will be recorded to have started at the start time of the race or start time of their class (if applicable).

#### **10.0 THE RACE**

#### **10.1 Starting Penalties**

Any vessel early over the line will perform an 'end to round' on either side of the starting line and restart the race.

**10.2** For the safety of all race participants, the NFCC Race Committee strongly recommends the wearing of a life jacket during the race.

#### **11.0 THE FINISH**

#### **11.1** There will be a RC boat at the finish line:

The finish line shall be an imaginary line extending 300 feet south from 'STA' (29:54.912 N; 81:15.280 W). As a courtesy, the finishing yacht should make an obvious turning maneuver.

#### **12.0 PROTESTS**

Submit all protests in writing to the Race Committee after the race no later than 10:00am Sunday, May 24. Notice of protest is also required to be given to RC when the yacht crosses the finish line.

#### **13.0 TROPHIES**

1<sup>st</sup> thru 3<sup>rd</sup> place flag trophies will be awarded in Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker, and Cruiser classes.

#### 14.0 POST-RACE

Results and awards will be announced during the party at the American Legion Post 37 (downtown St. Augustine). All non-racing cruisers are 'expected'!
