About the Brewer's Cup:											
A long-standing tradition, Smyrna Yacht Club has hosted the Michelob Regatta each October since 1999 attracting between 20 and 30 participating boats from across Central Florida -- a notable feature on the Indian River. This will be the 7th year of the new Brewers Cup sponsored by Smyrna Yacht Club. The Brewers Cup is a downwind pursuit race with a staggered start for any and all sail boats that can navigate the Indian River. More specifically, the Brewers Cup is a downwind "FUN" race occurring between the Smyrna Yacht Club and Mosquito Lagoon, a distance of about 10 miles. The direction -- either racing North or South -- is chosen to create a downwind race which allows many of the boats to fly their colorful spinnakers. The race will have a staggered start so that as many boats as possible will finish close together. This is probably the most spectacular sailing event of the year based on close quarter spinnaker competition.
