




FCSA Statistics

 In 2019 almost 20% of FCSA Certificate holders did not belong to any sailing club.
 This has been reduced to 18% in 2020.

 In 2019 only 57% of our total Certificates belonged to boat owners who are members of FCSA member clubs. <u>This has been</u> increased to 67% in 2020.




Almost 20% of FCSA Certificate holders do not belong to any sailing club. Only 67% of our Certificates belong to members of FCSA member clubs.



2020 Projects PHRF Rules Update Revised PHRF Certificates

PHRF Rules Update

- In general, the PHRF Rules are cleaner wording and shorter document.
- Added ToT in addition to ToD.
- Removed unnecessary wording related to Race Management. Focus on PHRF Rating.
- Boats are now classified as Sport Boat,
 Performance, or Cruiser (SB, P, C).



PHRF Rules Update

- Classes are more defined based on sailing characteristics of the boat.
- Roller furling credit is more carefully defined and several boats will be corrected.
- Eliminated crew weight restrictions.

More About Roller Furling

- Over 90% of Cruisers have roller furling. There are 18 boats that were built since 2000.
 - All 18 of these boats were designed with roller furling headsails as referenced in boat literature.
 - 6 of these boats have base boat ratings that reflect
 OEM roller furling which indicates these boats are correctly rated.
 - The other 12 have been given a roller furling credit of +6 sec, even though they came from the builder with stock OEM roller furling. These boats will need to be corrected.

More About Roller Furling

- In Performance class, we have 5 boats that have a +6 roller furling credit even though they came from the builder in that configuration and the base rating reflects the original design with roller furling.
- This will also need to be corrected.
- If you see a change in your Certificate it may be due to a previous error in handicap adjustment that is now being corrected.

Revised PHRF Certificate

- More comprehensive intended to aid in rating the boat.
- Includes Definitions diagram to aid in measuring sails and rig.
- Each Certificate Holder will now see how the adjusted rating is calculated.
- New Rating Application form contains builtin calculations to aid in filling out the form.

Revised PHRF Certificate

- This year we will continue to improve the form.
- Future project to include on-line payment for Certificate renewal.
- This year will require some work by Certificate Holders to update and supply missing data. This will be used to update our database and will facilitate renewal process.

By-Laws Revision

 In accordance with FCSA By-Laws Section 15.2, the By-Laws may be amended or a new By-Law made by a two-thirds vote of the members present and voting at annual or special general meeting provided the proposed amendment or new By-Law be stated in full in the notice of the meeting.

By-Laws Revision

- Many things have changed since the establishment of First Coast Sailing Association in 1998.
- Several of current practices in the operation of FCSA are outside of our By-Laws.
- In the Board's opinion it is necessary that we correct our By-Laws to be consistent with our current operation.
