





13th ANNUAL COWFORD CUP The Florida Yacht Club Jacksonville, FL May 4-5, 2023

Notice of Regatta

1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) 2021-2024 and the Prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association. The equipment regulations and rules of each one design class will apply.
- 1.2 The organizing authority is The Florida Yacht Club.

2. Disciplines

2.1 Optimist Championship Fleet, Optimist Green Fleet, 420 non-spinnaker, club 420, Laser Radial, and Laser 4.7

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 Competitors in the Optimist classes must have been born on, or after, January 1st, 2008
- 3.2 Competitors in the 420 and Laser Radial classes be 18 years or younger.
- 3.3 A minimum of 5 entries to make a class.

4. Schedule of Events and Races

4.1 Saturday, May 4th

- 0800-1000 Registration/Check-in, FYC SAILING CENTER
- 1000 Skipper's Meeting, Sailing Center
- 1100 Warning Signal for first race (back to back races to follow)

4.2 Sunday, May 5th

- 0930 Warning Signal for first race (back to back races to follow)
- 1400 No race will be started after 1400
 - Awards to immediately follow racing at the Sailing Center

5. Fees

- 5.1 Entry Fee: Singlehanded \$75 (\$100 after April 29th, 2024) Double handed \$150 (\$200 after April 29th, 2024)
- 5.2 Entry fee **includes a regatta T-shirt** for skipper and crew and taco bar Sunday at the awards ceremony.
- 5.3 Fees need to be registered and paid through clubspot.

6. Sailing Instructions

6.1 The Sailing Instructions will be published on clubspot before the event and on the official notice boat.

7. Racing Area

7.1 The Racing area shall be on the St. Johns River, east of The Florida Yacht Club.

8. Scoring

- 8.1 The Low Point Scoring System of rule Appendix A will apply.
- 8.2 One race shall constitute a regatta.
- 8.3 If six or more races are completed a boat's worst score will be excluded from her total.

9. Prizes

9.1 Trophies will be awarded to the top finishers in their respective classes. Participation awards will be given to Optimist Green Fleet participants.

10. Disclaimer of Liability

10.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. Neither the organizing authority nor the host organization, nor the sponsors accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

11. Lodging/Logistics

12. History:

12.1 The great city of Jacksonville was not always named after Andrew Jackson. In its early years it was named after the fact that the area near present day downtown was a very popular crossing point of the St. Johns River for ranchers and their cattle herds, due to the narrow width between sides. The name of this regatta celebrates the grand history of Jacksonville and its relationship to the St. Johns River, as was described in the city's original name of COWFORD.
